

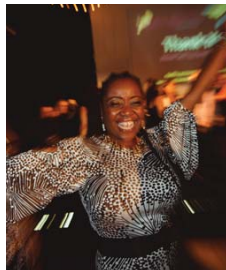
# This One's for the Ladies
